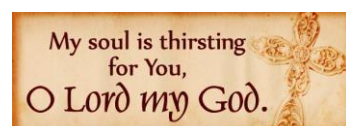
The Tabernacle Candle in the church burns this week in loving memory of Sheila Fisher, from Rod & Robbie Mai.
