



**Hourly Captains Needed for Perpetual Adoration**

In order to begin “24 Hour Perpetual Adoration” at St. Peter the Apostle in Fort Worth ministry volunteers need to be trained as “hourly captains.” The ministry of an “hourly captain” takes the responsibility for scheduling adorers of Holy Eucharist for a specific hour each day of the week. For example: The hourly captain for 9 AM would be responsible for scheduling worshipers for that hour 7 days each week; i.e. Sunday through Saturday. *When he returned to his disciples he found them asleep.
